The plan protects you against exposures associated with your educational duties, such as:

- Contract Negotiations
- Corrective Action and Evaluations
- Non-Renewal Notices

NOTE: IASA/ ISSA does not initiate litigation on behalf of members.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

In order to access these legal benefits, IASA must be kept informed about any litigation involving a member even if such litigation is the responsibility of the board of education.



AASA Provides

The AASA professional liability plan provides backup coverage when your school district's insurance is insufficient or they refuse to defend you. **The plan covers up to \$1 million in damages for professional and employment liability lawsuits**, including student injuries, improper hiring, defamation, civil rights violations, and employee-related issues. Defense costs are paid in addition to the \$1 million liability limit for professional liability cases. After a \$100 deductible, the plan covers 90% of attorney fees up to \$25,000 for employee lawsuits, sexual misconduct accusations (if found not guilty), and criminal charges from corporal punishment (if found not guilty). This valuable benefit is available through AASA's partnership with the Trust for Insuring Educators.

Additionally, AASA's Legal Support Program reimburses up to \$2,000 per year of continuous membership (maximum \$20,000) for legal expenses in job-related due-process proceedings, with expanded coverage since 2011 that includes investigation, negotiation, arbitration, settlement, and defense costs. To be eligible, you must be an active AASA member in good standing who works as a W-2 employee of a school, college, or university as your main occupation.

Your District Provides

- Various levels of insurance to protect the district and those acting in roles as appointed.
- •Representation that will often cover you as an administrator performing assigned duties, but protection is not absolute. The district's attorney is not your attorney.
- •Legal counsel to protect the interests of administrators when situations related to "defamation," "libel," or slander" occur, but the district is not obligated to do so.

It's not Personal

ISSA membership provides legal support associated with your educational duties, but it does not provide support for personal matters such as:

- •Cases involving Defamation of Character (e.g.: libel and/or slander)
- •Criminal Cases (e.g.: CSC, drunk driving, etc.)
- •Personal Legal Matters (e.g.: wills, trusts, divorce, etc.)

To receive legal assistance, the association member must:

- •Be an active member in good standing at the time the alleged act occurred and is a member in good standing at the time a request for assistance is made. Further, membership must be maintained during the entire period that assistance is rendered.
- •Have received approval for assistance from the IASA Executive Director or Associate Executive Director before being assigned to or engaging legal counsel.
- •Cooperate fully with the association and/or legal counsel in matters regarding his or her defense.
