



Subject: Ensuring FAPE for All IDEA-Eligible Children in Dual Enrollment Programs

Dear Special Education Director

The Idaho State Department of Education has proposed revisions to the Idaho Special Education Manual to ensure that a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) is available to all children with disabilities who are IDEA-eligible, consistent with 34 CFR §300.2(b).

The proposed revisions address eligible children with disabilities participating in Idaho's dual enrollment program ensuring that all eligible students are provided with FAPE. Public agencies, including LEAs and charter schools, must:

1. Review the proposed changes to the Idaho Special Education Manual, review and make changes to local policies and procedures necessary to ensure FAPE is provided to all eligible students
2. Identify whether any child with a disability in dual enrollment has been denied appropriate services under IDEA.
3. Determine whether compensatory services are appropriate to address any missed or insufficient services.
